3. Since January 2025, President Trump has worked to secure [the freedom of at least 26 American hostages](#) from hostile countries around the globe, including six American citizens freed from Venezuela, two American hostages in Afghanistan, and an American-Israeli citizen in Belarus.

Additionally, the Trump Administration established [the Presidential Working Group on Digital Asset Markets](#) to strengthen U.S. leadership in digital finance.
10. On March 2, 2025, the Trump Administration [ended fines against small businesses](#) for failing to abide by onerous reporting requirements, allowing for greater investment and growth opportunities in the American economy.

On January 29, 2025, Trump Signed The Laken Riley Act Into Law

- The [Laken Riley Act](#) required illegal immigrants arrested or charged with theft-related crimes, or those accused of assaulting a police officer, to be detained with Immigrations and Custom Enforcement.
- The Laken Riley Act also allows states to sue the Department of Homeland Security for harm caused to their citizens because of illegal immigration.
- The law was named for Laken Riley, a 22-year-old Georgia college student who was murdered by an illegal immigrant.

Since January 2025, President Trump Has Secured Trillions In New Investments In U.S. Manufacturing, Production, And Innovation

- In April 2025, the White House [identified over 45 companies](#) committed to investing trillions in America, including:
- Project Stargate, led by Japan-based Softbank and U.S.-based OpenAI and Oracle, [announced](#) a \$500 billion private investment in U.S.-based artificial intelligence infrastructure.
- Apple [announced](#) a \$500 billion investment in U.S. manufacturing and training.
- NVIDIA, a global chipmaking giant, [announced](#) it will invest \$500 billion in U.S.-based AI infrastructure over the next four years amid its pledge to manufacture AI supercomputers entirely in the U.S. for the first time.
- IBM [announced](#) a \$150 billion investment over the next five years in its U.S.-based growth and manufacturing operations.
- Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Company (TSMC) [announced](#) a \$100 billion investment in U.S.-based chips manufacturing.

Since January 2025, President Trump Has Worked To Secure The Freedom Of At Least 26 American Hostages From Hostile Countries Around The Globe

- In January 2025, President Trump [secured the release of six American hostages](#) from the Government of Venezuela after a meeting between President Maduro and an envoy of the Trump Administration.
- In the early hours of the Trump Presidency, President Trump [secured the freedom of two hostages from the Taliban in Afghanistan](#), with one of the hostages being held since August 2022.
- In February 2025, President Trump was able to secure [the release of an American citizen](#) held hostage in Belarus.

On January 28, 2025, President Trump Issued An Executive Order Entitled “Protecting Children From Chemical And Surgical Mutilation”

- This [executive order](#) worked to end the use of surgeries, hormone therapy, puberty blockers on children under the age of 19 years old.
- As a result of this order, hospitals in [Illinois](#), [Colorado](#), [Washington DC](#), and [Virginia](#) have suspended sex change procedures on minors.

On The First Day Of His Term, President Trump Established The Department Of Government Efficiency

- The Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE) [has worked](#) to eliminate government waste and to maximize government efficiency and productivity.
- Since its creation, DOGE has estimated saving taxpayers [over \\$160 billion](#), in sales, contract cancellations or renegotiations, fraud and improper payment deletion, grant cancellations, interest savings, programmatic changes, regulatory savings, and workforce reductions.
- Due to the work done by DOGE, President Trump [worked to eliminate waste and abuse at USAID](#), leading to the closing of that agency after determining it as “unaccountable to taxpayers as it funnels massive sums of money to the ridiculous — and, in many cases, malicious — pet projects of entrenched bureaucrats, with next-to-no oversight.”

In January 2025, President Trump Worked To Eliminate “Diversity, Equity, And Inclusion” Initiatives In The Federal Government

- The Trump Administration has [estimated](#) saving at least \$420 million in contracts focused on DEI initiatives.
- In January 2025, the Trump Administration’s decision [already sidelined](#) 395 government bureaucrats, allowing for greater efficiency and responsibility for tax payer funding.
- Additionally, The Trump Administration [changed federal contracting rules](#) to eliminate DEI considerations.

The Trump Administration Has Taken A Number Of Actions To Hold Universities Accountable For Allowing Antisemitism On Campus

- In January 2025, President Trump [signed the executive order](#) entitled “Additional Measures to Combat Anti-Semitism” which included efforts to hold colleges accountable for growing antisemitism on their campuses.
- In March 2025, the federal government [cancelled grants and contracts](#) to Columbia University totaling \$400 million in response to the inaction taken by the university to address antisemitism on their campuses.
- In March 2025, the Department of Education [announced additional measures](#) to end antisemitism on college campuses, saying “Measures will include a comprehensive review of federal contracts and grants given to institutions of higher education that are being investigated for dereliction of duties to curb or combat Anti-Semitic violence and harassment”

In February 2025, President Trump Signed The Executive Order Entitled “Expanding Access to In Vitro Fertilization”

- This executive order [outlined efforts](#) to expand policy options “to protect IVF access and aggressively reduce out-of-pocket and health plan costs for such treatments.”
- The executive order [highlighted the cost of IVF](#), stressing that the cost ranging from \$12,000 to \$25,000 per cycle needed to be address to ensure access to as many Americans as possible.

During His Second Term, President Trump Worked To Unleash The Power Of Cryptocurrency

- In March 2025, President Trump [established The Strategic Bitcoin Reserve And United States Digital Asset Stockpile](#) to make America the global leader in cryptocurrency.
- Additionally, the Trump Administration established [the Presidential Working Group on Digital Asset Markets](#) to strengthen U.S. leadership in digital finance.

In March 2025, The Trump Administration Ended Fines Against Small Businesses For Failing To Abide By Onerous Reporting Requirements
